Narragansett Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve

About Us:

The Narragansett Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (NBNERR) is a DEM program located on Prudence Island in Narragansett Bay, Rhode Island and is one of 29 Reserves in the National Estuarine Research Reserve System (NERRS). This is a network of protected areas established for long-term research, education, and stewardship. This partnership program between NOAA and the coastal states protects more than one million acres of estuarine land and water, which provides essential habitat for wildlife, offers educational opportunities for students, teachers, and the public, and serves as living laboratories for scientists. Prudence Island is only accessible via passenger ferry leaving from the Town of Bristol. The island has no commercial development; although the summer population may swell to over 1,000 on busy weekends.

Primary Job Responsibilities:

Job responsibilities include a wide range of manual tasks such as grass mowing, painting, and assisting in other maintenance work necessary in the daily operation of the Narragansett Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve. This is a standard 40 hr/week position that will be administered by the RI DEM. The salary is \$10.50 to \$11.00/hr depending on past employment at DEM. This position is available for up to six months of employment.

Requirements:

The candidate must be at least 18 years old, pass a physical and have a clean background check. A valid driver's license is also required.
